

HISTORY OF THE ASSOCIATION

Saskatchewan Field Hockey Association is a non-profit Provincial Sports Governing Body which promotes the development and play of Field Hockey in Saskatchewan. It is operated by an elected volunteer Board of Directors and a Technical Director/Provincial Coach. Sask Field Hockey receives funding through the Saskatchewan Lotteries Corporation. Additional funding is received through membership dues, program fees, fundraising, and sponsorship.

The mandate of our association is "to promote, encourage, organize, and regulate the sport of Field Hockey in the province of Saskatchewan in accord with the laws of the game and regulations of Field Hockey Canada and to represent the interests of Saskatchewan Field Hockey Association and members in National, Provincial, and local matters."

The association was organized in 1972 in Saskatchewan and field hockey has been played in Canada since the late 1800's.
